  - Registration for these feiseanna is handled by QuickFeis If you haven't registered with QuickFeis before, you'll have to create family and dancer profiles. Please note, if you've previously been on a team or competed at Oireachtas, you will have an account already since the MidAmerica Region Oireachtas uses QuickFeis..
  - As we've communicated previously, Nationals Ceili Teams are required to perform in teams at the 10,000 Lakes Feis on Sunday. Solo competition at the June Feiseanna is at your own discretion, though we encourage you to compete.
  - These feiseanna are hosted by the Mulhern school. Other than the teams competition and Natalie's support of first feis dancers, Cormac and Natalie will not be there. It is the same weekend as a large CIM event at the Celtic Junction. We will encourage other teachers to be there to support dancers.
